October 13 -16, 2021
(Delegates' Assembly on Friday, 15 October)

The national congress and exhibition of the French firefighters is a major event for the Fire and Rescue community.

Cancelled in 2020, the 127th event will now take place in Marseille at Parc Chanot from 13 to 17 October 2021 on a new site, in an exceptional setting, where all the assets of the Bouches-du-Rhône department will be assembled.

It will not only be a highlight for the 250,000 firefighters in France but also a landmark event for the French National Civil Protection service.

The 2021 Delegates' Assembly of the CTIF will also take place during this important event. The French Firefighters' Association are very pleased to welcome CTIF colleagues and representatives from all around the World to beautiful Marseille.

2.1 - Venue

The 2021 French Firefighter's Congress and Exhibition and CTIF Delegates' Assembly will take place at "Parc Chanot" exhibition and conference centre.

- Over 100,000 sq. m of indoor and outdoor areas all on one site: Marseille Chanot [Parc Chanot](#) has 5 exhibition halls in the city centre.
- Easy access for visitors:
 - 10 minutes from the Vieux Port
 - 5 metro stops on a direct line from Saint Charles TGV station
 - 30 minutes from Marseille Provence international airport
 - 3 hours from Paris by high speed trains TGV (17 connections every day)

By airplane:

Marseille-Provence International Airport

By train:

Marseille Saint-Charles train station, located in the heart of Marseille

Over 200 trains daily

- Charles de Gaulle Airport :3h40

- Barcelona: 4h34
